Process

- > Select unit that requires painting
- > Select suitable colour match – sample or RAL colour.
- > Final agreement on actual colour
- > Preparation and delivery 2-3 weeks after colour match agreed

Specification

Units are striped back primed, base layer and final layer applied. Colour match based on sample or defined RAL colour.

Please note: The stated lead times are a guide, this can be influenced by the design and complexity of the requirement.
